# How to read this assessment schedule

At the top of each page you will see the four main timetable blocks, A, B, C, D

X Side (7B1, 7EH1, 7S1, 7T1)		Y Side (7B2, 7EH2, 7S2, 7T2)	
7A	7B	7C	7D

If you are in 7B1, 7EH1, 7S1 & 7T1 then you only need to look at the **first two** columns labelled “X Side”

If you are in 7B2, 7EH2, 7S2, 7T2 then you only need to look at the **second two** columns labelled “Y Side.”

The assessments will be held during your normal timetabled lesson so you can use classcharts to help.

For example: the student below is on the X side and most classes are in band A.

The schedule on the coming pages will show first the subject, then the class name, then the teacher.
