# How to read this assessment schedule

At the top of each page you will see the four main timetable blocks, A, B, C, D

X Side (8B1, 8EH1, 8S1, 8T1)		Y Side (8B2, 8EH2, 8S2, 8T2)	
8A	8B	8C	8D

If you are in 8B1, 8EH1, 8S1 & 8T1 then you only need to look at the **first two** columns labelled “X Side”

If you are in 8B2, 8EH2, 8S2, 8T2 then you only need to look at the **second two** columns labelled “Y Side.”

The assessments will be held during your normal timetabled lesson so you can use classcharts to help.

For example: the student below is on the X side and most classes are in band A.

The schedule on the coming pages will show first the subject, then the class name, then the teacher.
